## 2. Create a “Recipe for an Awesome Mom!”

Example:

Recipe for an Awesome Mom!

- 1 teaspoon of understanding
- 2 teaspoons of happiness
- 1 tablespoon of fun
- 2 tablespoons of sweetness
- 1 cup of love, intelligence, and beauty
- A pinch of goodness
- And a sprinkle of sunshine

### 3. Create a class video for all mothers

Ask students to send you a short video of them saying why they love their mom or record your students live during your class

- You can use platforms such as Flip Grid, Google Classroom, or Seesaw

Combine all student videos into a single video

- Include an opening and closing slide, such as “Dear Moms” or “Love, Room 4”
- For extra fun, include a picture of each kid with his/her mom in between videos (make sure that you consider your school’s photo release policy)

Email the video out to all families on Mother’s Day as a surprise

NOTE: For any students without a mother present in their lives, they can alternatively explain why they love their caregiver and the video can be addressed to “family.”
