S weet


U nderstanding

2. Create a "Recipe for an Awesome Mom!"

Example:

- And a sprinkle of <u>sunshine</u>




3. Create a class video for all mothers

Ask students to send you a short video of them saying why they love their mom or record your students live during your class

- You can use platforms such as Flip Grid, Google Classroom, or Seesaw

Combine all student videos into a single video

- Include an opening and closing slide, such as "Dear Moms" or "Love, Room 4"
- For extra fun, include a picture of each kid with his/her mom in between videos (make sure that you consider your school's photo release policy)
